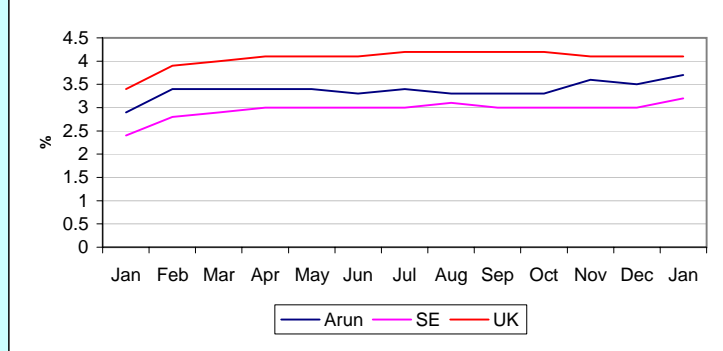

**Claimant Count Rate 2009 - 2010**

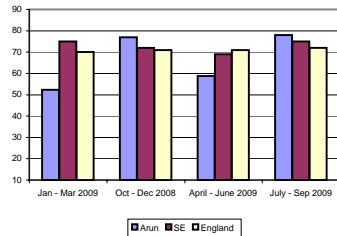

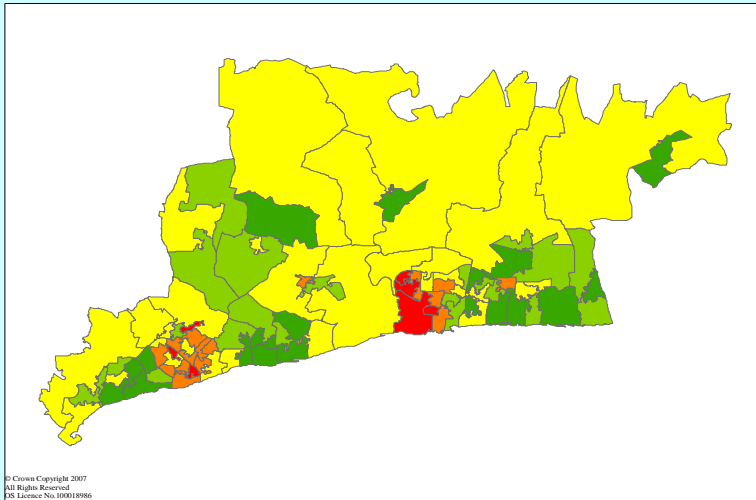
