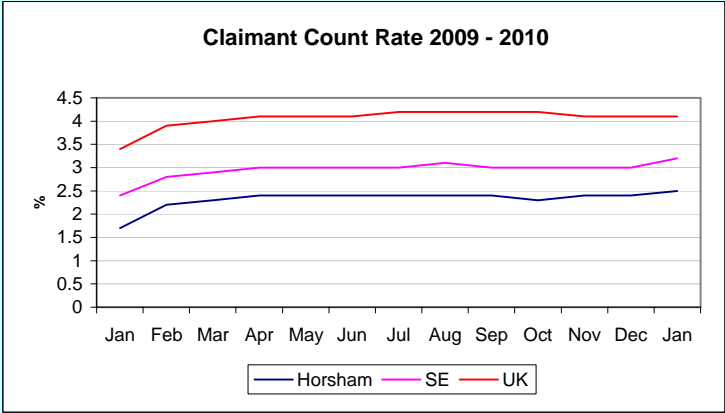

Percentage of Major planning Applications Determined within 13 Weeks



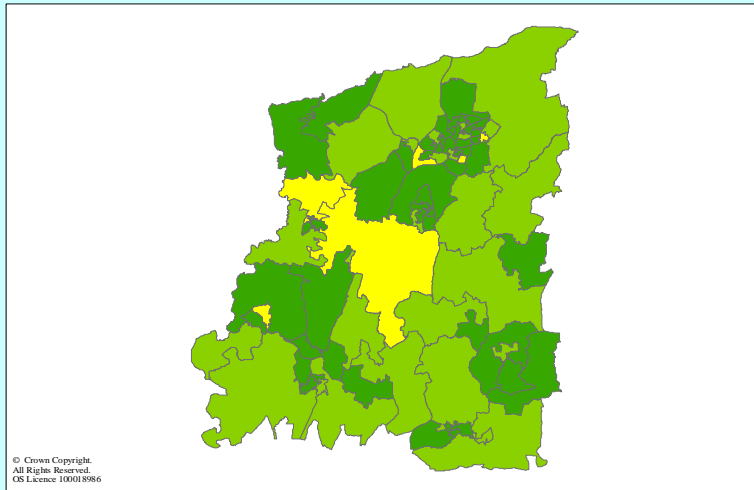
