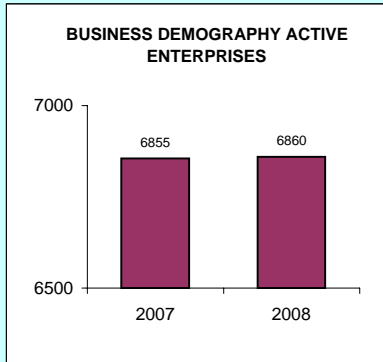

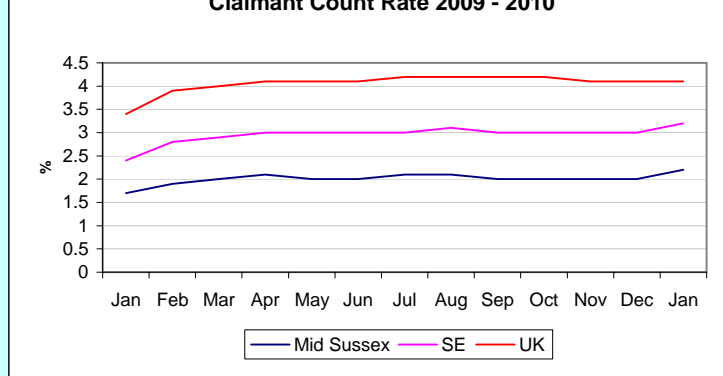

Claimant Count Rate 2009 - 2010

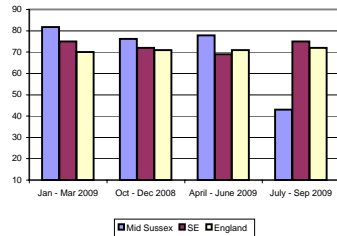

Percentage of Major planning Applications Determined within 13 Weeks



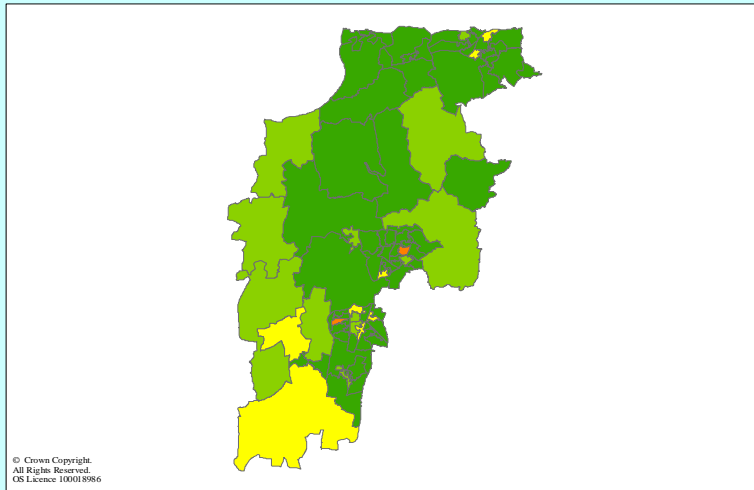
